 - 2. Housing for 40 workers
 - 3. Malt house and grain storage
 - 4. Cellars and grain storage
 - 5. Brewery for dark and Muscovite beer
 - 6. Friedrich's residence; underneath vaulted fermentation rooms
 - 7. Company office and homes for Friedrich's sons, Leopold, and Michael Balsler (Abraham's brother-in-law); underneath vaulted cellars
 - 8. Coachman's home, stables, washing room
 - 9. Housing for 120 people, workshops, cellars
 - 10, 11. Stables for the horses of the factory
 - 12, 14. Wooden sheds
 - 13. Water pump
